Following its momentous three-year journey, 150 ports in over 20 countries and 42,000 nautical miles around the globe, the Polynesian voyaging canoe, Hōkūleʻa, returns to Maui. Please join us in this very special one-night event, as we welcome her crew to Montage Kapalua Bay. Learn about the Malama Honua Worldwide Voyage and its mission to train a new generation of navigators, develop community stewards and grow a global movement of "Caring for the Earth." This special event recounts the history of Hōkūleʻa, its wondrous journey around the world and the many lessons learned as told by crew members that sailed aboard this iconic voyaging canoe.

*Forty years ago, Hōkūle'a, Star of Gladness, began as a dream of reviving the legacy of exploration, courage, and ingenuity that brought the first Polynesians to the archipelago of Hawai'i. In 2014, Hōkūle'a set sail around the world. This journey was called Mālama Honua (caring for Island Earth) Worldwide Voyage. The voyage has celebrated a resurgence of pride and respect for our native cultures and has created opportunities for people throughout the world to honor our shared heritage.
